Notes for Roof Construction

- Engineered scissor Trusses 5/12 pitch
- Sheathed with 7/16 OSB
- Ice and water shield 36" up from eaves and valley
- Clad with 25 year shingles
- Details for Insulation, Fascia, Soffit on separate Detail sheet
