

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF McMURRICH/MONTEITH  
BY-LAW 04 - 2018**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF THE  
WASTE DISPOSAL SITE**

located at 2161 Hwy 518 West, Part Lot 12, Concession 10,  
RP 42R-10567, Part 1, RP 42R-13316, Part 1

**WHEREAS** Section 10(2) A single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting the following matters: 7. Services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide under subsection (1);

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of McMurrich/Monteith deems it necessary to regulate the operation of the Waste Disposal Site;

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of McMurrich/Monteith enacts the following:

**SECTION 1-DEFINITIONS**

- 1.1 “Bag/container” shall mean a non-returnable clear or transparent plastic bag or container which is for residential garbage
- 1.2 “Council” shall mean the Council of the Township McMurrich/Monteith;
- 1.3 “Domestic Waste” shall mean the waste produced by residents in their homes;
- 1.4 “Garbage” has the same meanings as waste;
- 1.5 “Recyclable” shall mean those classifications of waste capable of being diverted from the normal waste stream;
- 1.6 “Refuse” shall mean the same as domestic waste;
- 1.7 “Salvaging” shall mean the process of finding items for the purpose of reuse;
- 1.8 “Scavenging” shall mean the process of finding items for the purpose of reuse;
- 1.9 “Township” shall mean The Municipal Corporation of the Township of McMurrich/Monteith;
- 1.10 “Waste” shall include domestic and solid non-hazardous, non-recyclable refuse and other wastes as designated and as approved by the Ministry of Environment;
- 1.11 “Waste Management Facility” shall mean the property situated at located at 2161 Hwy 518 West, Part Lot 12, Concession 10, RP 42R-10567, Part 1, RP 42R-13316, Part 1

**SECTION 2- GENERAL PROHIBITIONS**

- 2.1 No person shall deposit garbage; debris and other refuse, other than the areas prescribed by the Landfill Attendant or as indicated by clearly marked signs.
- 2.2 Every person shall only deposit waste produced within the Township of McMurrich/Monteith,
- 2.3 Every person shall ensure that Waste is in a clear/transparent bag for disposal.
- 2.4 No person shall enter the waste disposal site when the gates are locked.
- 2.5 No person shall set a fire at the waste disposal site.

- 2.6 No person shall deposit refuse by the locked gates when the site is closed.
- 2.7 No person shall deposit large rocks, stumps, sewage, toxic or hazardous wastes and chemicals, explosives, volatile materials, pathological wastes, or used vehicles, in the Site.
- 2.8 Every person shall, dispose of recycled materials in the appropriate designated bins at the waste disposal site.
- 2.9 No person shall be permitted to Scavenge from the waste management facility, other than from the reuse center.
- 2.10 No person shall yell at or threaten the Land Fill Attendant

**SECTION 3-SITE OPERATIONS**

- 3.1 Staff will not tolerate yelling, threatening, foul language, throwing of garbage or recycling
- 3.1.1 Failure to comply with this by-law will result in the Township exercising its right to prohibit any person or business from using the waste management facility.
- 3.1.2 Schedule “A” attached to this by-law regulates the hours of operation and the applicable tipping fees.

**SECTION 4-PENALTY PROVISIONS**

- 4.1 Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33.
- 4.2 Every person who is guilty of an offence under this by-law may, if permitted under the Provincial Offences Act, pay a set fine and the Chief Judge of the Ontario Court (Provincial Division) shall be requested to establish, pursuant to the Provincial Offences Act, set fines in accordance with Schedule “B” of this Bylaw.

**SECTION 5-SEVERABILITY**

- 5.1 If a Court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or part of a section of this by-law to be invalid, such section or part of a section shall not be construed as having persuaded or influenced Council to pass the remainder of the by-law and it is hereby declared that the remainder of the by-law shall be valid and shall remain in force.

**SECTION 6- REPEALS**

- 6.1 By-law 16-2013

**SECTION 7-EFFECTIVE DATE**

This By-law shall take effect upon being passed and enacted.

Read a first and second time this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2018.

**Schedule "A"**

**Hours of Operation and Applicable Tipping Fees**

1. The Waste Disposal Site will be open to the residents and ratepayers of McMurrich/Monteith Township 5 days per week (Friday – Tuesday) in the months from April 1<sup>st</sup> – November 30<sup>th</sup> for the hours of 9:00am to 5:00pm. During the months of December 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>, the Waste Disposal Site will be open from 1:00pm – 5:00pm Monday to Friday and 9-5 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays. The Site will be closed every Wednesday and Thursday of every week. The site will be closed on all Stat Holidays from November 1 – May 1<sup>st</sup>.
2. All Freon bearing appliances will be accepted at the Disposal Site for a fee of \$35 providing all doors have been removed. The Municipality will be responsible for having a technician remove the refrigerant from these units.
