

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF McMURRICH/MONTEITH

BY-LAW 16 - 2013

Being a by-law to regulate the operation of the Waste Disposal Site located at 2161 Hwy 518 West, Part Lot 12, Concession 10, RP 42R-10567, Part 1, RP 42R-13316, Part 1

WHEREAS Section 11(1) authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters within the sphere of waste management;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of McMurrich/Monteith deems it necessary to regulate the operation of the Waste Disposal Site;


THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of McMurrich/Monteith REPEALS by-laws 14-2005 and 01-2013 and ENACTS the following:

1. No person shall fail to deposit garbage; debris and other refuse in areas as prescribed by the Waste Disposal Site Attendant or as indicated by clearly marked signs. Failure to adhere to this policy will result in a fine of \$200.00.
2. No person other than a township resident or ratepayer will deposit garbage in the Township Waste Disposal Site unless otherwise prearranged with the Waste Disposal Site Attendant. Unauthorized persons so doing will be subject to a fine of \$200.
3. No person shall enter the waste disposal site when the gates are locked. Persons doing so shall be subject to a fine of \$200.
4. No person shall set a fire at the waste disposal site. Persons doing so shall be subject to a fine of \$400.
5. No person shall deposit refuse by the locked gates when the site is closed. Persons doing so will be subject to a fine of \$200.
6. No person shall deposit large rocks, stumps, sewage, toxic or hazardous wastes and chemicals, explosives, volatile materials, pathological wastes, or used vehicles, in the Site. Persons doing so will be subject to a fine of \$200.
7. No person shall fail to dispose of recycled materials in the appropriate designated bins at the waste disposal site.
8. No person shall remove scrap metal from the scrap metal pile. Persons doing so will be subject to a fine of \$200.
9. No person shall use deposit their garbage in black garbage bags. Persons doing so will be subject to a fine of \$200. The Township of McMurrich/Monteith has a clear garbage bag policy.
10. Schedule "A" attached to this by-law regulates the hours of operation and the applicable tipping fees.
11. Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as prescribed in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33.


The payment of a violation notice as set out in this by-law is a voluntary out-of-court settlement and if payment is not made in accordance with this by-law, a fine imposed pursuant to this by-law is recoverable under the Summary Convictions Act.

BY-LAW 22 - 2013


Schedule "A"

Hours of Operation and Applicable Tipping Fees


1. The Waste Disposal Site will be open to the residents and ratepayers of McMurrich/Monteith Township 5 days per week (Friday – Tuesday) in the months from April 1st – November 30th for the hours of 9:00am to 5:00pm. During the months of December 1st – March 31st, the Waste Disposal Site will be open from 1:00pm – 5:00pm. The Site will be closed every Wednesday and Thursday of every week.
The site will be closed on all Stat Holidays from November 1 – May 1st.
2. All Freon bearing appliances will be accepted at the Disposal Site for a fee of \$35 providing all doors have been removed. The Municipality will be responsible for having a technician remove the refrigerant from these units.
3. Tipping Fees will be imposed on the following:
 - a) Car tires (on rims) - \$5.00 each
 - b) Truck tires (on rims) - \$10.00 each
 - c) Larger than 19 inch tires (on rims) - \$15.00 each
 - d) Large Appliances and furniture items (incl. mattresses) - \$6.00 each
 - e) Fridges/freezers & air conditioners - \$35.00 each
 - f) Non-burnable demolition materials such as asphalt shingles and dry wall will be determined by Disposal Site Attendant by the amount of materials ranging from \$25.00 - \$150.00
 - g) Exception to Tire Tipping Fees – Since the Township of McMurrich/Monteith has executed an agreement with Ontario Tire Stewardship: residents and ratepayers will be allowed to bring in four tires free per year before the above fees will apply.
 - h) Fibreglass boats - \$150.00
 - i) Truck caps - \$50.00

Read a third time and finally passed this 16th day of September, 2013.
